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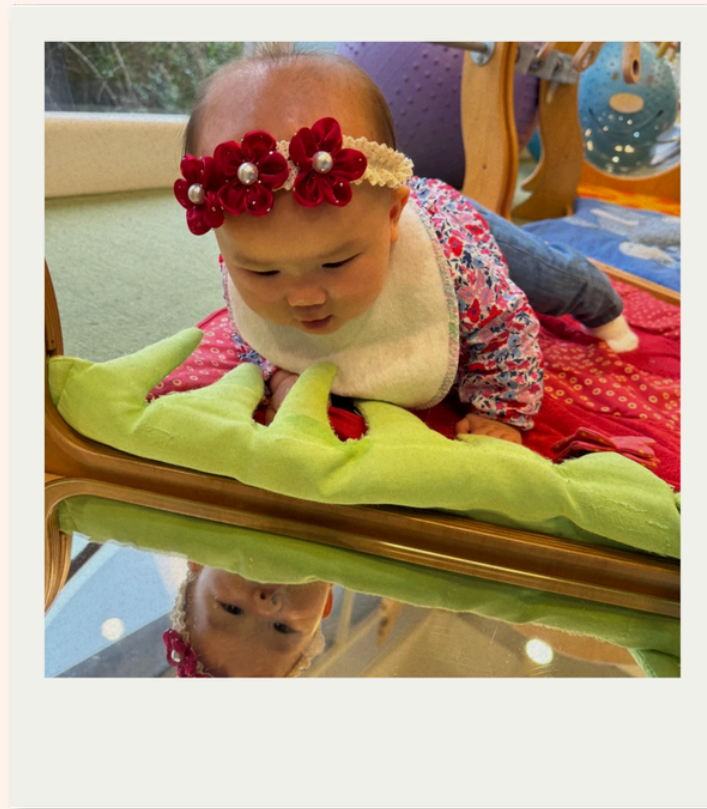

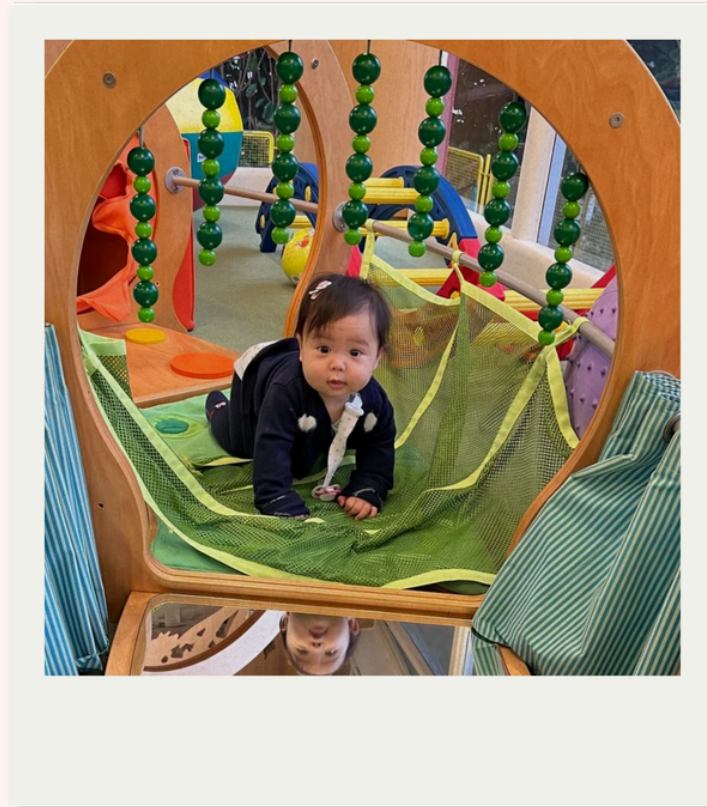

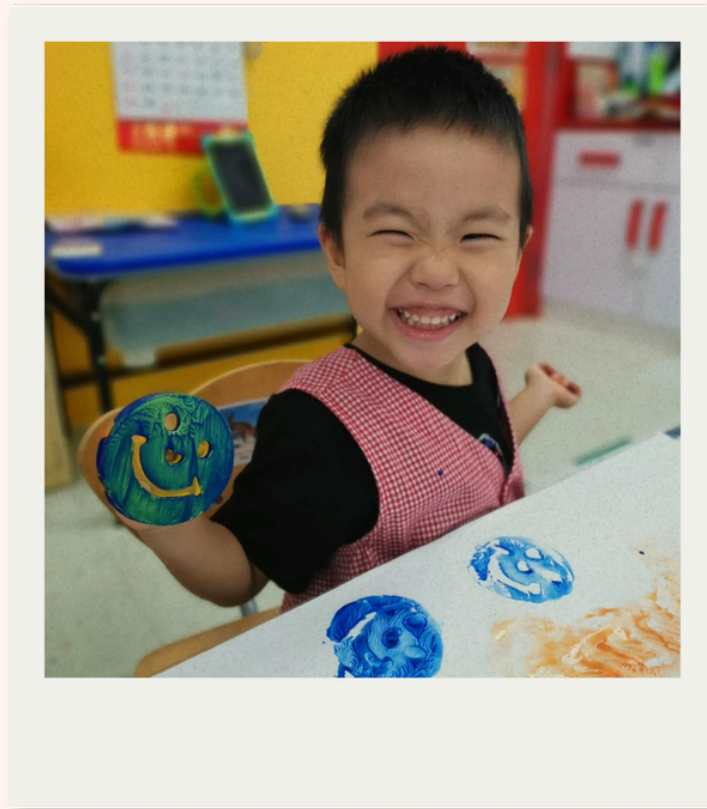

"The little gray sleeping bag brought from the mainland is Aiden's most vivid memory of his first days in Hong Kong.

In the autumn of 2024, our family had just crossed the Shenzhen Bay checkpoint, dragging boxes of all sizes as they moved into Hong Kong Island. Three-year-old Aiden, with his new backpack, stood at the gate of TUTOR TIME Kindergarten, his eyes holding both curiosity and a timid glimmer.

"Kindergartens on the mainland all have nap time," I specially sent the sleeping bag to school with him.

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Within the first week, messages from his teacher revealed that he was already adapting to Hong Kong's rhythm—no long naps, just a short rest. When school ended at 4:30 in the afternoon, he would return home bursting with energy, like a little beast fully recharged.



An even bigger change happened on the school bus.

On the first day, when I sent him off, he would always grip the door and look back wistfully. A week later, he was already expertly giving high-fives to the driver, buckling himself in, and sharing stickers with the classmate beside him. The school bus auntie remarked, "Aiden is so caring now. When new children cry, he helps take care of them."

These words would later become Aiden's new defining trait.

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From then on, Aiden seemed to have found his "mission." Whenever there was a new classmate—whether from Beijing, Taipei, or overseas—he would proactively approach them, using every word and gesture at his disposal to help them adjust to the new environment and daily routines.

In his own way, he told new friends: Don't be afraid, I've only been here a short time too, but I already love it here. Over a year has passed, and he has gained friends from all over the world. His weekend playdate calendar is often completely full.

Once, I asked him, "What do you like most about Hong Kong?" He thought for a long time, then said seriously, "I like school, I like my teachers, and I like teaching new friends."

I thought back to that sleeping bag—it had long been put away in the deepest part of the cupboard, no longer needed. But what Aiden gained was something far more important than a naptime habit: a child's soft adaptability, an actively caring heart, and childhood friendships that transcend cultures.

From arriving with a sleeping bag, to embracing the world with open arms. The changes over this past year have been like the Hong Kong spring breeze—gentle and quiet, yet leaving a deep imprint on the heart. "
